



RIOT GAMES PRIVACY NOTICE VCT GAME CHANGERS EMEA SERIES

I – Scope

Riot Games, Inc., Publisher of the game VALORANT (“**Riot**”), the Data Controller under GDPR, has mandated DivE, the Data Processor under GDPR, a non-profit organization promoting gender diversity in Esports (“**DivE**”), to operate the GAME CHANGERS SERIES EMEA competition as part of VALORANT Champions Tour, dedicated to women players (“**Game Changers**”).

The hereby Privacy Notice applies to any collection and/or processing of your personal data as processed in the context of the Game Changers.

We may need to modify this Privacy Notice at any time, in particular in order to comply with changes made to the current laws and regulations, without ever lowering the protection of your personal data.

II. Which personal data will be collected by DivE?

As part of your registration and participation in the Game Changers, DivE will process the following information on behalf of Riot Games (altogether “**Personal Data**”):

- Name, First name;
- E-mail address;
- Nickname;
- Riot ID;
- Discord ID;
- Date of birth;
- Photos to be used on broadcast and social media to promote the teams participating to the Game Changers (*eg - on Riot Games official Social Media pages*).
Players have a right to ask to remove the pictures if they believe it is detrimental to them (Section VII).

Age, residency and gender will be checked by DivE in order to confirm your eligibility to the Game Changers which is a competition dedicated to women. In particular, DivE will ask you



to show on webcam documents as proof of your eligibility. DivE will not keep any record of the documents used to verify your age, gender and residency.

DivE will collect and process such Personal Data on behalf of Riot Games, exclusively for the purpose of your participation in the Game Changers. Please note that the use of your Personal Data is necessary to participate in the Game Changers. If you do not want DivE to use your Personal Data, you cannot participate in the Game Changers.

Your Personal Data is collected by any means necessary and in particular via the registration Google form and by private emails.

Any processing will be carried out on the basis of your participation in the tournament and in compliance with any applicable regulations and in particular the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) which became effective on May 25, 2018.

In order to check your eligibility to participate in the Game Changers, DivE may carry out an identity check to verify the residence, nationality, date of birth and gender of each participant.

As mentioned in the Game Changers RuleBook (accessible here: https://bit.ly/GC-EMEA_Rulebook) the players must be able to provide to prove residency age and gender:

To prove nationality, date of birth and gender (which can also be used as proof of residence):

- a. Government issued documents - e.g., government benefits record, military registration etc.*
- b. Private Documentation - e.g., school records, deeds, leases, homeowner association docs, utility bills*
- c. Any official identity document e.g., national identity card, passport, birth certificate.*

As mentioned above, DivE will not keep any record of the documents shown.

III – Why do we collect these data?

Riot Games will use your data exclusively for the purpose of your participation in the Game Changers.

The purposes of collecting and processing your personal data are:



- Check of the identity of each player according to the eligibility requirements for the participation in the Game Changers;
- Anti-cheat control to prevent fraud;
- Internal communication (email, Discord) to provide you with all necessary information related to your participation in the Game Changers.

Riot Games guarantees that your personal data will not be processed for purposes other than those set out above.

IV – Recipients of your Personal Data

The recipient of your Personal Data is Riot Games as the data controller, and DivE acting as a data processor, a non-profit organization promoting gender diversity in esports by organizing dedicated events and tournaments.

Your personal data will not be transmitted to third parties under any circumstances, with the exception of cases where their communication is strictly necessary for the management of the Game Changers such as :

- The "nickname" and "Riot ID" will be communicated to Riot for anti-cheat control purposes.

Riot Games guarantees a level of security in accordance with legal requirements.

Riot Games may communicate your Personal Data to certain public entities in order to meet legal obligations. In any case, Riot Games undertakes not to transfer, exchange or sell your Personal Data to third parties.

V – Storage and security of Personal Data

Storage of your Personal Data

Riot Games stores the personal data, with a service provider specializing in data storage and security.

As such, all the provisions provided for in this Privacy Policy, as well as the obligations arising from the GDPR are applicable to it.

Security of your Personal Data



Riot Games undertakes to take all necessary measures to protect your Personal Data against any destruction, accidental loss, alteration, dissemination or unauthorized access, as well as against any unlawful processing of Personal Data or their communication to unauthorized third parties.

In particular, these measures may be, encryption of processed data, establishment of a system limiting access to Personal Data to certain duly authorized persons, establishment of firewalls, etc.

In the event of an intrusion or security breach affecting your Personal Data, we will promptly inform you and do everything possible to neutralize the intrusion and limit its impact within the time limits set by law. In the event of damage suffered by you as a result of the intrusion, we are committed to providing you with the necessary assistance in order to assert your rights.

VI – How long do we keep your Personal Data?

Your Personal Data will only be processed for the duration of your participation in the Game Changers.

Such Personal Data will be deleted:

- once the Game Changers is terminated for any other relevant Personal Data.
- In any case, your Personal Data related to residency, age and gender will not be stored.

VII – What rights do you have over your Personal Data?

In accordance with applicable law and regulation, you have the right to access, rectify and delete your Personal Data, as well as the right to object and limit processing.

In addition, you have the right to the portability of your personal data. This right allows you to receive and transmit the personal data that you have provided to us in a structured and readable format.

These rights can be exercised on simple request to dpo@riotgames.com



Before responding to your request, we may ask you for additional information and to justify your identity.

We do our best to respond to your request as quickly as possible and, in any case, within the time limits set by law.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 13 of the GDPR, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority, namely the CNIL, if you consider that we have not respected your rights.
